

## **Attachment B**

### **Courses, Exams and Theses**

#### **1. ECTS-Credits**

The DD Program joining the degree of European studies at the Palacky University, Faculty of Law and the degree of Salzburg University, Center of European Union studies, comprises 120 ECTS credits.

The semesters of the master's program spent at either home or host institution shall be fully recognized. The examinations of the courses taken at the host institution, considered as equivalent to examinations taken at the home institution, are specified below.

Students have to acquire at least 20 ECTS at the host institution. The host institution is obliged to organize courses in English language, which enable students from the home institution to acquire 30 ECTS voluntarily. At most 30 ECTS acquired at the host institution can be recognized for the degree program at the home institution.

Students participating in this program shall produce a master thesis. The students participating in this program shall also pass the final exam at home institution. Thereafter, it shall be awarded the degree "MA" at the Paris Lodron Salzburg University and the degree "Magistr" (Mgr.) at the Palacky University Olomouc. Only after receiving a degree at the home institution, the host institution awards the corresponding double degree.

#### **2. Courses followed at the host institution**

Students from the Palacky University have to select the following courses of the Paris Lodron Salzburg University - Master Program European Union Studies,

because of its special nature and organization of those courses only at the Center of European Union Studies of Salzburg University:

- Obligatory two Interdisciplinary seminars so-called “Planspiele”
- Additional courses specializing in EU affairs from the Master Program’s course program, corresponding with the Palacky University, Faculty of law European studies course program for future possible recognition at the home institution.

All selected courses have to be agreed upon with the selected coordinator of the host institution as conditions for fulfilling the preconditions of the double degree concerning the one semester study at the host institution.

Students from the Salzburg University shall during their stay at the host institution obligatory select following courses, if they are not presented in the courses program at the Salzburg University:

- Politisches System in der Tschechischen Republik/Policy System of the Czech Republic – (4) ECTS
- Einführung in das Recht/Introduction to the Studies of Law – (3) ECTS
- Grundzüge des Verfassungsrechts/Introduction to Constitutional Law – (5) ECTS
- Grundzüge der Verwaltungsorganisation und der Verwaltungstätigkeit/Introduction to Administrative Law and Administration – (6) ECTS

The remaining courses required to reach the minimum requirement of 20 ECTS credits can be selected from the electronic course list of the Law faculty of the University Palacky Olomouc or discussed with the corresponding coordinator.

Students are advised to clarify the details of the courses to be pursued at the host institution before start of the semester with both the coordinators of the home and host institution. Students can further apply for recognition of the courses at the host institution at the study the coordinators of the master programs in advance.

Partner universities will organize and support short time excursions of the DD Master Programs students from the partner institutions. During those excursions will the students have the possibility to obtain basic information about the host institution and country; they can also study a part of obligatory courses, depending on the corresponding time schedule of the excursion. For this reason the Salzburg University, the center of European Union studies has established special course „Praxisseminar, Transformation in Mittel- und Osteuropa“ and the Palacky University Olomouc has established special course „Přípravný seminář pro Double Degree studium“. Special courses mentioned above will be rewarded by ECTS credits.

Both institutions are obliged to announce changes in their European Union study programs that may influence the conditions for the DD program.

### **3. Theses**

Students participating in this DD Program can complete their master thesis at the home institutions. The DD Program candidate can choose one main supervisor from the home institution where the theses work is carried out and shall be allocated and second supervisor or coordinator from the host institution. The

thesis should be submitted and examined at the institution where the thesis work has been carried out. Both supervisors should be members of the examination board for the master exam.
